

Use of club boats & equipment

- 1. Buoyancy Aids must be worn at all times.
- **2.** Club members are permitted to use club equipment if suitably trained. All members must sign in/out equipment in the diary in the club entrance lobby.
- Cadet members may only sail with rescue boat cover.
 Cadet members can use club equipment if an adult is either on the water or supervising from the shore.
- Cadets <u>must not</u> take part in activities on the water in offshore winds unless a safety boat is manned or safety precautions have been put in place.
 Preferred conditions are force 4 onshore winds and rising tide.
- 5. All members using club equipment must know the harbour limits and club boats must stay within the harbour limits unless suitable safety boat or safety precautions have been put in place. Any member/cadet going beyond harbour limits is responsible for their own safety and the club accepts no liability.
- **6.** Ensure that boats are suitably rigged before launching and you are suitably trained to use the club equipment safely.
- **7.** Harbour limits are displayed on the notice board in the clubhouse entrance and on notice board outside main door.
